Consent Agenda

Consent agenda, approval of payroll Bulla made a motion to approve consent agenda, seconded by Roberts. Passed 3-0.

Old Business

A. Executive Session for Personnel Matters of Non-elected Personnel K.S.A 75-4319(b)(1), no binding action was taken. Motion made by Bulla and seconded by Roberts, passed 4-0. Regular session resumed at 7:15pm.

New Business

A. Senior Center-Bulla reported that Chief Bryan brought to her attention that the AED machine is not working and that the pads are expired. Bulla brought it up to the Senior Center board and they want them replaced and brought up some concerns that no one is trained on how to use the AED machine. Bulla asked is there a personal liability if someone from the Senior Center uses it and Koehn stated it would fall under Good Samaritan. Cranford stated that our fire dept can go to the senior center and replace the pads and get it up to date. Cranford also thought it would be a great idea for the City, Fire and Senior Center to have the Red Cross class and Bulla agreed. Chief Bryan stated that he could come replace the pads and give a refresher on how to use the unit. Chief Bryan also said he could organize a CPR class as well.

B. City Insurance – Koehn wants Darren Woodson to go over the list of items on the policy and correct some of the items and put in better detail and resubmit it to the insurance company. Tabled until the next meeting.

C. Planning Commission resignation from Steve Jones – Mayor Satterthwaite stated that we thank him for his service to the city on the planning commission. Bulla made a motion to accept the resignation of Steve Jones from the Planning Commission, seconded by Koehn, passed 4-0.
Mayor Satterthwaite stated that there will be a comprehensive planning workshop on March 9 at 6pm at the senior center.

Koehn would like to open the gate to the triangle where the mulch pile is so people can come get some if they want any and Koehn said she would give her phone number out so residents through the newsletter so if there is anyone interested, they can call her, and she can open it to them.
