Consent Agenda –Toyia Bulla made a motion to approve the consent agenda, seconded by Chris Chippeaux, passed 5-0.

Budget Workshop – Bentley Police Dept is requesting a FLOCK SAFETY License plate reader and software to lease. Council increased Law Enforcement budget to \$53,000 to accommodate for the license plate reader and software. Darren Woodson requested a Building Maintenance line item to track costs On building maintenance only. Shannon Koehn talked with council about the increased amount of water being used in the park. Shannon Koehn also stated that the parks sprinkler system needs to be checked for a leak. Reba Lee said she will contact Ryan's to see when they can come out and check the system. Council discussed possibly putting a well in the park for the grass only. Council increased Park & Rec budget from \$10,000 to \$20,000 to accommodate for water usage at the park.

Darren Woodson requested \$939.66 for valves from council. Shannon Koehn made a motion to approve expenditure for check valves and parts that Darren discussed not to exceed \$940.00, seconded by Toyia Bulla, passed 5-0.

Darren Woodson passed his water certification test.

Shannon Koehn made a motion to set out for bids for cleaning city hall on the marquee, newsletter, website, and Facebook for bids to be submitted to the city clerk in writing and accept bids until the second meeting in September, seconded by Toyia Bulla, passed 5-0.

Toyia Bulla made a motion to approve the one bid submitted for the boards and doors for \$285.00, seconded by Shannon Koehn, passed 5-0.

Reba Lee requested to Public Works that the weeds in castle estates roads be sprayed.

Brad Jantz requested from council and staff to communicate with him on what they would like to see on the Code of Ethics or what they would like to have removed.

Brad Jantz and Council decided to hold a special meeting on Monday, August 30 at 6pm to finalize budget.

Shannon Koehn made a motion to adjourn at 9:12 p.m., seconded Toyia Bulla, passed 5-0.
